

## **Updated Information for the Rain Event on July 23rd**

On July 22, 2010, the Village of Brown Deer experienced over 5 inches of rain, with some areas of Milwaukee County reporting over 8 inches of rain, including close to 6 inches in the hour from 5:00 – 6:00 p.m. This event exceeded the capacity of sanitary and storm sewers. We are in the process of assessing the damages. If you have experienced flood damage, please send your name, address, phone number, and email to [manager@browndeerwi.org](mailto:manager@browndeerwi.org). The Village can be contacted by phone at 371-3000, however email is preferred.

Dumpsters have been placed and are located in areas of the Village where the largest concentration of flood damage calls have been received. The dumpsters will be emptied and relocated as necessary. If there is not a dumpster near your house, please place flood damaged items at the end of your driveway; DPW crews will be picking it up.

If you have a contractor coming in to remove carpeting, drywall etc. please contact the Department of Public Works (414-357-0120) and we will do our best to have a dumpster located in your area.

Tetanus shots are still available from the North Shore Health Department through Friday July 30<sup>th</sup>, to residents participating in the flood cleanup in the following communities; Brown Deer, Glendale, River Hills, Fox Point, and Bayside. Please contact the Health Department located at Brown Deer Village Hall by phone at 371-2980 to schedule an appointment. Brown Deer Village Hall is located at 4800 West Green Brook Drive.
